Measles and the MMR vaccine

A guide for visitors to prison

There have been cases of measles in Wales. Measles can make some people, such as pregnant women, people with a weak immune system and babies, very unwell.

The best protection against measles is **two doses** of the safe MMR (measles, mumps and rubella) vaccine.

- Measles is an infection caused by a virus. It spreads quickly between people who are not vaccinated.
- You can catch measles by touching a person with measles or by breathing in the virus when they cough or sneeze.
- If you or your child has not had two doses of the MMR vaccine, you can get them **free** from your GP surgery.
- If you are not sure if you or your child has had two doses of the vaccine, ask your GP surgery - it's not too late.
- If you or your child has symptoms of measles, **stay at home** and phone your GP surgery or contact NHS 111 Wales by **phoning 111**. It is free to call this number. **Stay away** from your GP surgery and A&E - you could spread the illness to others.

- Os nad ydych yn siwr a ydych chi neu'ch plentyn wedi cael dau dos o'r brechlyn, gofynnwch i'ch practis meddyg teulu - nid yw'n rhy hwyr.
