



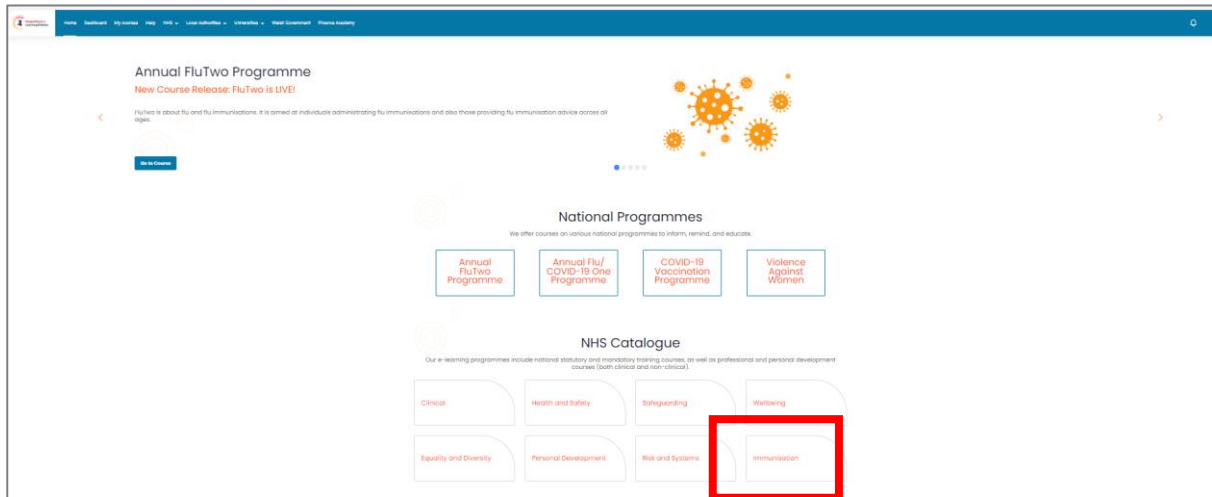

Select the module you wish to complete.


You will be prompted to enter an enrolment key, see table below
