Programme co-developed with Public Services Boards' (PSB) members and officers, Welsh Government, Future Generations Commissioner's Office, and local public health teams.

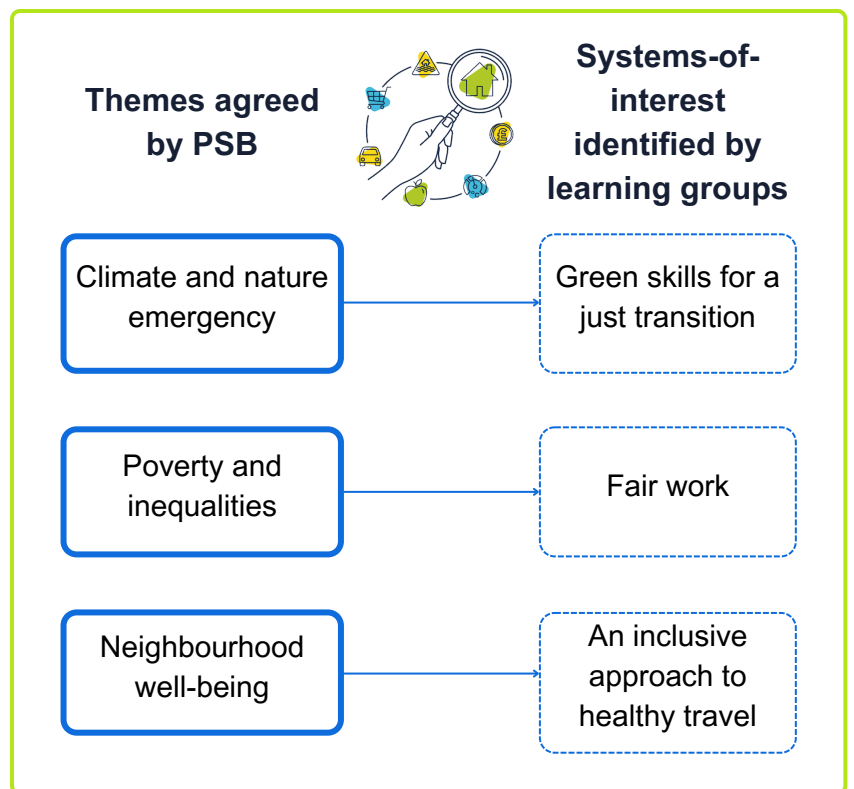
Purpose

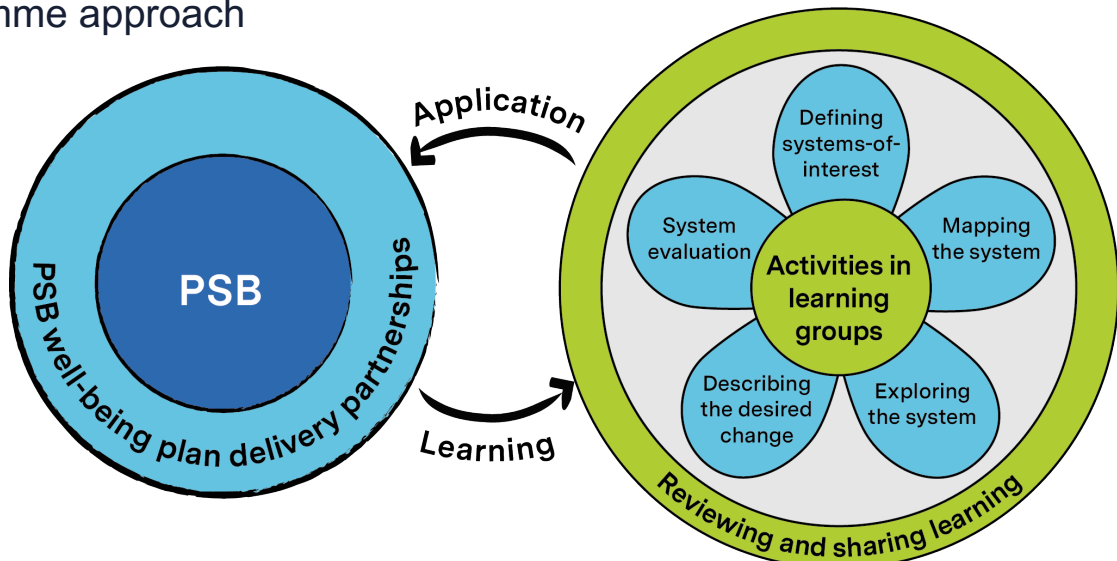
Evaluation

The programme is supported by a learning and evaluation framework.

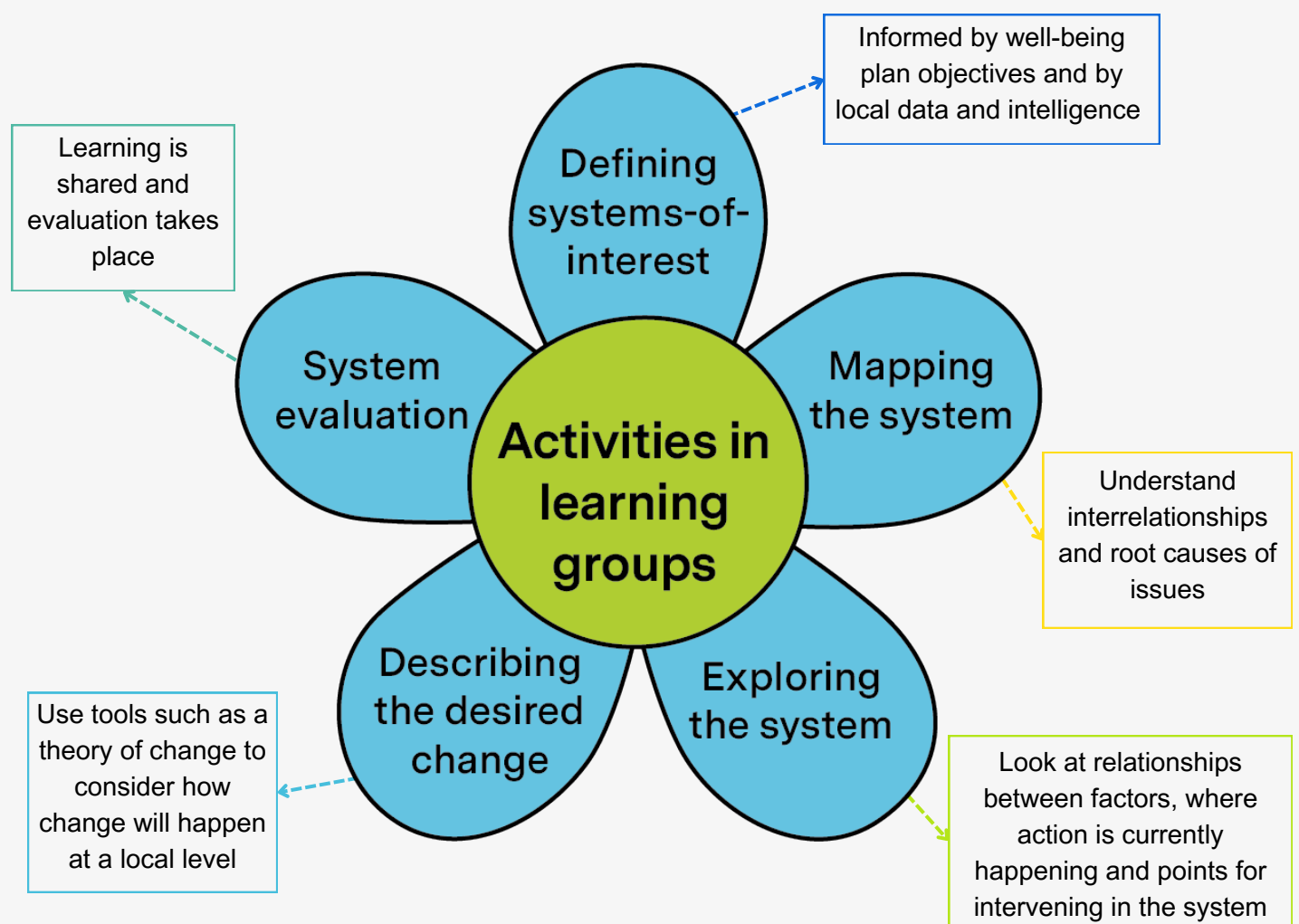
Focus
